ASHA JYOTHI TAKES-UP ANOTHER STEP FORWARD...!



Asha Jyothi has been steadily progressing well in providing enormous services for the people living with HIV/AIDS from its inception in the year 2006, with varied multiple services. A new scheme known as 'NUTRITION DISTRIBUTION for TB INFECTED CHILDREN' once in every three months has been introduced. Asha Jyothi had identified 135 poor and

deserving such children infected with T.B. in the entire district of Medak and distributed Nutrition to all of them for a faster recovery.

Another important break-through for Asha Jyothi (AJ) in the field of HIV/AIDS is to provide, HOME-BASED CARE; a novel concept to help the HIV infected and affected orphan children living in Medak district. Through this project, AJ provides medical health care, nutritional support and formal education by sending them to schools. All such children are kept under the custodial care of their kith and kin in their own homes. This novel program was formally launched and inaugurated on 26th September, 2014 by our Provincial Superior, Rev. Fr. Antony Joseph SVD and the Provincial Procurator Rev. Fr. N. Anand SVD was also present for the programme. The Master of the Ceremony (MC) Mr. Veerabau kept the crowd spell-bound after every event by his attractive words. Fr. Felix Roche, the superior welcomed the dignitaries with floral tributes while Fr. AlwinMascarenhas briefly explained all about AJ activities. Three of the out-reach workers explained their nature of work in their various programs and their achievements. Arnold Children Home children staged three beautiful dances which were so pleasing to the eyes and touching the hearts! The Chief Guest distributed the 'NUTRITION PACKAGES' to the 30 children who are the beneficiaries of this program for this month and in his address he expressed his appreciation for the dedicated works carried out by AJ to the people living with HIV/AIDS.
