"How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news". This is how our sacred scripture adorns the indomitable spirit and the life promoting saga of the missionaries. Unlike the normal patterns in this world, the roads less travelled and the terrains which have not experienced the fragrance of the word of God, often becomes the fertile field where the spirit of God leads us, the missionaries. This was true in the case of St. Joseph Freinademetz, our first missionary to China

St. Joseph Freinademetz, while musing on his missionary life, humbly uttered the following words, "I do not consider missionary life as a sacrifice I offer to God, but as the greatest grace that God could ever have lavished upon me". Thus, for all of us, Divine Word Missionaries, he remains an epitome of missionary spirit. As we have just celebrated the feast of this great saint of ours, it is indeed worth that we take time to recollect and reflect for ourselves on the missionary voyage of this great missionary. I am confident, it will surely be a refreshing tonic, as we stretch our every sinew in our missionary efforts.

St. Frienademetz left for China with an open mind and heart like that of Jesus. He never went among them with a superior mentality; rather he treated them as equals. Above all, he promoted a vibrant church by forming local men and women as catechists and as living witnesses to Christ. His missionary spirit was such that he often repeated, "even in heaven, I want to be a Chinese", which was recognized by Pope John Paul II when he called St. Frienademetz as an 'Exemplary Model of Gospel Inculturation' on the day of canonization.

Vatican II document on 'mission' describes missionary activity as nothing else and nothing less than the manifestation of God's plan, its epiphany and realization in the world and in history. Today, this epiphany takes place concretely through the wide range of our ministries where we transcend our comforts to give 'God-touch' to the tribal people, to the leprosy affected and AIDS patients, to the people suffering from various diseases, to the children as we impart knowledge, and through our pastoral and formation activities. When we do these, we too become models of Gospel inculturation as St. Frienademetz was.

Let us be inspired humbly by these great efforts, we do in His vineyard. Let the fruits of our labour and our first missionary be our motivation. Let our spirits not be sagged by the sporadic fruitlessness or any sort of discouraging elements that unavoidably creep on our way. May we continue our great spirit of mission as one family following the footsteps of St. Freinademetz and assuming the spirit of our Founder.

NEW CHURCH BLESSING

- St. Alphonsa Church MIG: The long cherished desire and dream of the catholic faithful of BHEL to have a place of worship in their vicinity has come true with the blessing of the new chapel at MIG. The management committee of MIG allotted admeasuring 751 sq. yards for the catholic community. On February 22, 2004, Fr. Dominic Ekka the then parish priest blessed and erected a cross. In the year 2008, the foundation stone was blessed and laid by the late Archbishop Marampudi Joji for the construction of the Chapel. The Archbishop declared that BHEL and MIG Colony will be a MISSION on the same day (INH Circular, Feb. 2008, INH/PC/63). On December 19, 2010 was a historical and blessed day for the people of BHEL. Msgr. Swarna Bernard, the Apostolic Administrator of the Archdiocese of Hyderabad blessed the newly built chapel and Fr. A. Jesu, the Provincial Superior inaugurated the same. The concelebrated Holy Eucharistic celebration was presided over by the Apostolic Administrator. A good number of priests, nuns and faithful participated to witness the blessing of the sanctuary of God. On this auspicious occasion, 24 of our parish children received the Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Communion.
