Interculturality as Mission

Today, interculturality is one of the towering gifts we can offer to the emerging Church and to the world at large, as a congregation. This aspect is embedded in its pristine form in the founding moments of our Society. Our founder St. Arnold Janssen crossed the borders - in effect, led the way of being intercultural- to found our society. Our first missionary St. Joseph Freinademetz epitomized this aspect by his very life, for all of us to emulate. Therefore, it was not a mere accident when our 17th General Chapter elaborated and identified this aspect of Interculturality as the guiding principle for the future course of our missionary efforts.

Our outgoing General, Rev. Fr. Antonio Pernia set the tone for this, during the inaugural Mass by stating, "We are an international and intercultural missionary congregation. These two essential characteristics of our identity will provide the perspective for our reflections and discussions in this General Chapter.

What does being an international or intercultural missionary congregation mean today in the context of a world that is becoming more and more multicultural? What directions do we need to take? What actions do we need to undertake?"

We are international or intercultural not just by accident or by force, but by choice and design. This is echoed in the prologue of our constitution which states, "As a community of brothers from different nations and languages, we become a living symbol of the unity and diversity of the Church." Therefore, being intercultural today requires of us some basic personal attitudes, certain community structures and a special spirituality. If interculturality is our heritage, if interculturality is our commitment, then, we are called to live this basically in the following two ways in our missions.

Interculturality Ad Intra: Interculturality begins at home. As the sons of Arnold, therefore, we need to be inclusive of others in a diverse community. We need to have a sense of belongingness to the community we live in and a sense of belongingness to each other in the community. This should be augmented by celebrating the Eucharist together, by having meals together and by our lifestyles which is sensitive to each members of the community in which we live in.


Interculturality Ad Extra: Interculturality is also a rich form of spirituality. It is one of the best ways of giving witness to the unity and diversity of the Kingdom of God, for interculturality is one of the basic features of the Kingdom envisaged by Jesus (People will come from east and west, north and south will eat in the Kingdom of God (Lk 13: 29)). Today, multiculturality being the way of living due to globalization and information and technological revolution, how do we translate our experience of intercultural living in our missionary endeavours to be a true witness to His Kingdom?

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
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THE NEW GENERAL TEAM

Our Formation Houses

Jyothi Niketan, Narasaraopet

June 23, 2012 marked a triple celebrations at Jyothi Niketan, Narasaraopet; the inauguration of the new academic year, farewell to the Palda going students and welcome to the new staff and the students. The celebrations commenced with the solemn Holy Eucharistic celebration presided over by Fr. Francis Thuruthimattom SVD. Fr. Balaprasad SVD, the Rector preached an inspiring homily and invited the students to focus on the mission of Jesus and move ahead in their vocation journey. Fr. Having received the suggestions and the priorities from the districts/units, the Provincial Administration along with the districts superiors with due discussion and consideration will convert them into actions.

The Feast of St. Alphonsa

St. Alphonsa's Church at BHEL, MIG celebrated the parish feast on July 29, 2012. Fr. A. Jesu SVD, the Provincial Superior was the principal celebrant of the concelebrated festive Holy Eucharist. Fr. P. Sagayaraj SVD preached a meaningful homily explaining the life and values of St. Alphonsa, the Indian Saint. Fr. A. Joseph conducted an adoration preceding the Holy Mass and helped the people to pray in one mind and heart. The four parish choirs – English, Telugu, Hindi and Malayalam helped in one voice to have a solemn liturgical celebrations. The celebration was concluded with a fellowship sumptuous meal that provided an opportunity for the people to greet one another and cultivate a family spirit.

Specialized Apostolate Meeting

The meeting has provided certain vision and direction for all our JPIC activities. I thank Fr. Chalamana, the Province JPIC Coordinator for taking initiative to organize a meeting of all the social activists of our Province to evaluate and to devise effective ways and means to reach the most neglected people in the society.

Blessing of Research and Cultural Centre



Adhering to the directives of XVII General Chapter of the Society of the Divine Word, the INH province launched its venture of Research and Cultural Centre in Habsiguda. Fr. Jesu, the provincial superior inaugurated and blessed the Research and Cultural Centre in the premises of Divine Mercy Centre on July 14, 2012.

According to the vision-mission of the province, this centre will seek to promote research in the areas of anthropology, culture and religion. In its course of action the Centre shall identify the ecumenical and inter-religious dialogue partners and explore how they can best contribute to greater understanding of people of other religious traditions in the apostolates and what new initiatives could be undertaken in terms of ecumenical and inter-religious dialogue and cultural study, stated Fr. G. Lazar during the short ceremony of the occasion.

- 02. to help heal those confreres and communities which have been wounded or disoriented as a result of changes in the church and in the world; both individuals and communities may need help if their sense of self-worth and confidence is to be restored;
- 03. to renew the sense of spiritual purpose of both members and communities by animating them to accept in an ongoing way the unceasing call of God to a deep union with Christ;
- 04. to remind the members that they are called to serve the Church through our society as committed religious by placing their gifts and talents at the disposal of the Society and the Church for the good of others;
- 05. to challenge both individual members and communities by raising questions that need to be raised, in light of our general chapters and of the last general visitation.
- 06. to look ahead creatively and cooperatively to the future of the province: its future needs, its future concerns, its future directions.'
