# Faith as Mission

From 11th October 2012, we begin the Year of Faith in the Church. During this year, the Church invites all of us to reflect on the multifaceted dimensions of our faith. The models for faith abound in the Bible. Although the whole of the Bible is an inspiring account of faith, we find a very useful description of faith in the letter to the Hebrews: To have faith is to be sure of the things we hope for, to be certain of the things we cannot see (Heb 11:1). Faith is something that empowers humans to raise above their limitedness with the belief in the power of God. However, what happens in reality is that every attempt of human beings to raise above their limitedness is not grounded in the power of God, but very often, on their own strengths and their unbridled ego. Hence, the failure of human beings and the chaotic situations they are thrown into in their lives is, in a way, failure in their faith and misconception of their faith.



Today one of the greatest concerns of the Church is the dwindling number of the faithful participating in the liturgical celebrations, even in the traditionally catholic countries. In our country too, the declining interest of the youth in the liturgical activities is a great cause of concern. At the same time, we find people going on pilgrimage, visiting religious places, participating in the popular devotional practices. Also, a careful look at the world today would intimate us that people's thirst for spirituality has not gone down. We find the mushrooming of religious movements even in our country. In such a context, the prominent challenge before us religious is to bring up the faithful in faith. Therefore, expressing our faith today poses us two dimensional challenges: one is to reflect on our own faith personally, and another is to help our faithful to grow in their faith. Therefore, this year of faith means a lot to all of us, religious.

How do we express our faith as Divine Word Missionaries? In this regard, what is more important is that we check if all our missionary endeavours, whichever form it may take, communicate God's love to the people. It is by fruits, the goodness of the tree is determined. Similarly, in the transformation, our missionary efforts effect, our faith blossoms and is expressed. Faith cannot be just limited to our words. It should be authenticated by our deeds. If we can do this, we can bring up the people also in faith.

The communities we build should be witnessing communities. It is not just we encourage our faithful to attend the liturgical activities regularly. We should make efforts to translate the effect of our liturgical activities in the concrete life situations of the people. We should renew our people in faith. This faith should be an affective faith which transforms their life, as it did with the early Christians. We should not just be satisfied in quoting Mother Theresa in our homilies but we should be involved in inspiring many more Mother Theresas.


