Season of Grace

The journey of a woman from conceiving to giving birth, the journey of the gold ore in becoming an ornament, and the journey of stones in becoming adorable sculptures tell us how joy and pain, struggles and success, challenges and opportunities are not two but single, intertwined realities. Besides, today, the traditional Indian ethos is subjected to sterner test by the emerging, globalised India. Our response to these developing situations through our varied missionary endeavours will define and determine the nature of our missionary contentment in the years ahead.

In this context, the message of Lent should motivate us to opt for hard ways in life, to explore new avenues of continuing our mission and to face the challenges of our daily life gracefully. Only in our Churches, we worship God crucified. Only, our religion extols the meaning and the need of suffering to a great extent. Therefore, as missionaries we will be able to transform the world around us for better, only if we are ready to walk the hard way and communicate to those around us, the need to face the realities of life situations instead looking for comfort zones. May this season of Lent fill us with the required graces for the mission ahead of us.
