

Welcome to Deacon Alister Gomes SVD





AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON CYBER CRIME AND CYBER SAFETY IN CYBER CELL- BHOPAL





SAMMAN BHOPAL Organized an Awareness Programme on Cyber Crime and Cyber Safety in Cyber Cell of Bhopal. There were about 60 Youth from 6 different Centers were part of this Awareness Programme. The resource person DIG of Cyber Cell Bhopal and his Team explained various relevant aspects of Cyber Crime.

The objective of the Awareness Programme was to enlighten the Youth about Cyber Crime and Cyber Frauds thus, can be conscious about probable occurrences of crimes and also be capable of making the communities aware about it. Resource person DIG of Cyber Cell Discussed concerning, Positive and Negative sides of Cyber Crime with a case study related to Slum Youth. He also made aware how the crimes happen through Social Networking Sits, Such as, Online Frauds and Banking frauds Through Mobiles, Cyber Bullying, Fake Id's in social networking sites, etc. can victimize anyone across. They further dialogued upon anyone is duped through Cyber offenses; the Cyber Crime Cell expounded how to file the FIR and the procedures. Finally, Safety Measures for the use of Mobile and Social Networking Sits were Meticulously Explained. The Awareness program was very enlightening as the youth became more aware about the material world and the consequences correlated to the enslavement of Cyber World. Largely the Awareness Programme was very instructive, informative, and appropriate for all the Youth.

EDUCATIONAL EXPOSURE VISIT FOR THE SLUM CHILDREN

SAMMAN Bhopal Organized an Educational Exposure Visit for the Bridge Course and Tuition Center children along with Animators and Teachers from 10 different centers was carried out to the Regional Museum of Natural History Bhopal. There were about 200 children from across the centers participate in the Exposure Visit.

Director of the Museum welcomed the children and discussed on how to take the accountability in preserving the Natural History which is our rich inheritance. There were inputs on controlling the various pollutions and this influence the Plants and animals. Children were also made aware about the deadly Chemical Composition of Pesticides through videos which make all the living beings sick and damages our nature and thus, does not make us live in
