Confreres' Personal Bank Accounts

This issue of *confreres*' personal bank account came up in Provincial Council (PC) Meeting held on 06 June 2021 against the background of the *confreres* who died recently and had personal accounts but no nominee mentioned. In the light of this, the PC requests and makes it mandatory that the nominee details for that account to which the pocket money and the food allowance is being transferred be updated and a copy of it be sent to the Provincial's Office. Moreover, those *confreres*,

who have the bank account to which their salary is credited, kindly mention one of the province members as your nominee and submit the same to the office.

Collecting copy of Identity Cards and Updating the Home Contact details of the confreres

The Provincial Council considers it expedient to collect the copies of the Aadhar card, Voter's ID, Pan card, and at least two phone numbers of the home contact of each *confrere* of the Province. This is in view of the future reference and all these documents will be kept in the respective individual's files.

15th Death Anniversary of The Servant of God- Fr. Marian Zelazek SVD

The 15th Death Anniversary of Servant of God, Fr. Marian Zelazek, SVD was observed in Puri with due solemnity on April 30, 2021 with strict observance of Corona Standard Operating Procedure (SOP). The inmates of Ishopanthi Ashram began the day with thanksgiving worship in 'Father Marian Chapel' at the Ashram at 6.30 A.M. Father Marian's compassionate love for the people on the margins particularly for those denied of human dignity due to Hansen's disease and his promotion of universal brotherhood through dialogue among believers of different faith traditions in Puri were nostalgically remembered.

At 8.00 A.M. the Staff and representatives of the students of Beatrix School – popularly known as 'Father School' paid homage to the Founder of Beatrix School with floral tributes at his 'bust' in the School. The newly restored and renovated 'first building' of the Beatrix School, built by him was dedicated as 'FATHER MARIAN BLOCK'. The newly installed play facility of the School was dedicated to the memory of Father Marian as Father Marian Children's Park.

The main event of the day was observed at 9 A.M. at the 'Father Marian Memorial' where part of his mortal remains are interned. Sentimental and heart touching homage was paid to the founder of Karunalaya Leprosy Care Centre and Ishopanthi Ashram with chanting of religious songs and 'kirtan' by the inmates of 'Marian Ashraya' - the leprosy colony set up by him.

A moment of meaningful silence was observed in his fond memory. All present paid tribute to FATHER by placing lighted oil lamps and flowers at his *Samadhi*, amidst the singing of the *Kirtans*. The Teachers of Beatrix School sang a song –



"Return Once Again *Bapa* (Father)" in honour of the Servant of God.

A newly made documentary film and a video song in Odia on Father Marian - both produced by Fr. Dixson Lawrence D'Souza, SVD, were officially released and screened in Father Marian Museum.



A short Memorial Service was held at Karunalaya Leprosy Colony mainly for the benefit of the elderly, the sick, and the children. While some of them came in their tricycles, others slowly walked to the statue of Father Marian installed on his first death anniversary in front of the Karunalaya Hospital. The children of the colony joyously flocked around. It was a blissful gathering with singing, garlanding, and incensing the statue of Father. Children offered flowers to their beloved 'Bapa' and shared 'Prasadam' as gift from Father.
